A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR MINIMUM AMOUNTS OF TAX

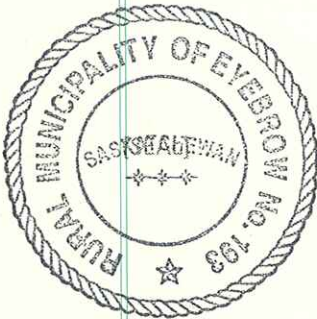
The Council of the Rural Municipality of Eyebrow No. 193 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

This bylaw shall be known as the "Minimum Tax Bylaw".

Pursuant to Section 339.2 of *The Rural Municipality Act, 1989* the following **minimum municipal tax levies** shall be applied on the following assessments:

|--------------------------------------|---------|
| 1. Agricultural Land only | \$25.00 |
| 2. Non-Arable (Pasture) Land only | \$25.00 |
| 3. Residential Land only | \$25.00 |
| 4. Residential Land and Improvements | \$25.00 |
| 5. Commercial Land only | \$25.00 |

** Where two or more parcels of land are owned beside each other, by the same person, the assessor shall combine the assessment of those parcels into a single assessment for the purposes of the assessment roll.*
